Level I and Level 2

Introduction & Eligibility

The Ladies Ancient Order of Hibernians, Inc sponsors a National Irish History Writing Contest for students in Grades 6 through 12. The contest is comprised of two levels: Level I is for students in Grade 6, 7, or 8 and Level 2 is for students in Grades 9,10, 11, or 12. Students who are enrolled in parochial, private, public or who are home schooled are eligible to participate.

Contest Timelines

- ✓ October 1, 2017 Contest begins
- ✓ November 15, 2017 Students are required to submit four (4) copies of their essay to the LAOH Division Historian
- December 15, 2017 Essays submitted to LAOH County Level Historian
- √ January 15, 2018 Essays submitted to LAOH State Historian
- February 15, 2018 Essays submitted to LAOH National Level Historian

Paper Length Guidelines

Level I- Not less than 500 words or more than 1,000 words

Level 2- Not less than 750 words or more than 1,500 words

Contest Rules and Guidelines

A Title Page is to be provided using double-line spacing. The student's name, address (either school, home or parish), city, state and zip code, school name, grade level, and number of words in paper exclusive of the Works Cited/Reference Section.

The Title Page should not be numbered. Page numbers are to be placed in the upper right-hand corner at 1/2 inch. Page numbers should be consecutive beginning with the first page of the body of the paper. The student's name should not appear on any page in the paper. The student's name is stated only on the title page.

Drawings, maps charts, and pictures are not to be included on the title page or in the body of the paper.

Double-line spacing is to be used throughout the paper including the title page, body, quotations and sources used.

All submissions are to be printed on white paper, single-sided only. Letter font is not to exceed 12 point.

Margins are to be I inch at the top, bottom and sides of page. Paragraphs are to be indented I/2 inch from left margin



If the quotation is less than 4 lines, the quote is to be incorporated in the body of the paragraph and if the quotation is more than 4 lines, it is to be indented one (1) inch from the left margin. Sources used are to be listed on a separate page after the body of the paper.

The Judging Criteria includes the following categories with their point values:

- Comprehension 30 points
- Organization 20 points
- ✓ Conclusion -15 points
- Creativity 20 points
- ✓ Writing -15 points.
