

INTRODUCTION & ELIGIBILITY

The Ladies Ancient Order of Hibernians, Inc. sponsors a National Irish History Contest for students Grades 6 through 12. The contest is comprised of two levels: Level 1 is for students in Grades 6, 7, or 8 and Level 2 is for students in Grades 9, 10, 11, or 12. Students who are enrolled in parochial, private, or public schools or who are home schooled are eligible to participate.

CONTEST TIMELINES:

1. Students submit entry to Division by 10/30/25
2. Division judges advance maximum of 7 entries by 11/30/25.
- 2.5. County Boards submit their top 7 at each level by 12/30/25.
3. State judges review, advance a maximum of 7 entries per level by 1/30/26.
4. National judges review, and return judging rubrics to the National Historian by 2/28/26.
5. National Historian will compile results, and announce all winners by 3/10/26.

- 3rd Place \$500

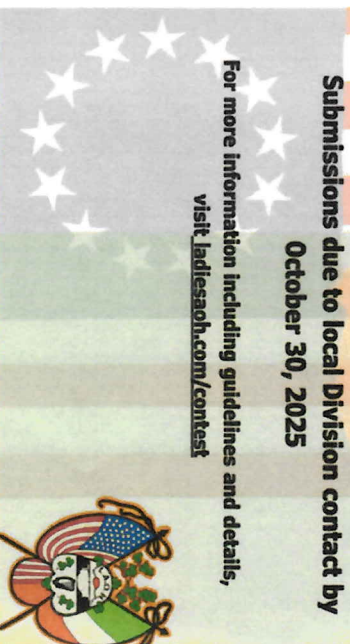
